The orchestral prelude preceding the third Act aptly sets the tragic scene we are about to witness; the sadness and desperation of a life drawing to a close. We are in Violetta's bedroom where she lies dying of consumption, attended by her faithful servant Annina.

“Addio del passato”

Il dottor Grenville viene a visitare Violetta e cerca di rincuorarla dicendole che la convalescenza è vicina ma, uscendo, egli confessa ad Annina la gravità della malattia svelando che a Violetta non restano che poche ore di vita.

Violetta viene a sapere da Annina che per le vie di Parigi si festeggia il Carnevale e le chiede dunque di prendere 10 Luigi (la metà della somma che le rimane) e di uscire per distribuirli ai poveri. Rimasta sola Violetta esstra dal seno una lettera di Germonet ed inizia a leggere a bassa voce. Lo scritto la informa che Alfredo e il Barone si sono battuti in duello e quest'ultimo è stato ferito, seppur non gravemente. Alfredo, rifugiatosi all'estero, è stato da lui informato del sacrificio di Violetta, al più presto, tornato in Patria, verrà da lei a chiedere perdono. "E tardi!" commenta desolata Violetta davanti allo specchio, osservando i mutamenti causati in lei dalla malattia, c'ha l'addio ai sogni felici del passato ed ha una visione della sua tomba senza fiori e senza nome. "Addio del passato": è questa la commovente aria.

E

Dr. Grenville visits Violetta and seeks to provide comfort by reassuring her that convalescence is close at hand. However, he confesses the gravity of the situation to Annina as he leaves, telling her that her mistress has only a few hours left to live.

Violetta hears from Anna that the streets of Paris are celebrating Carnival and beckons her servant to take 10 gold Louis (half of the money she is left) and distribute it among the poor. Violetta is left alone. She takes her broom a letter from Germont and begins to read quietly alone to herself. The letter recounts a duel between Alfredo and the Baron, during which the latter was lightly wounded. Forced to flee abroad, Alfredo has been informed of Violetta's sacrifice and is intent on returning as soon as possible to Paris in order to beg her forgiveness. "It's too late!" despairs Violetta. Facing herself in the mirror, she observes the changes her illness has wrought on her appearance and sings farewell to the happy dreams of the past. In a moving aria, she bids "Farewell, happy dream of by-gone days" and pictures a nameless grave with no flowers upon it.

D

Doktor Grenville kommt Violetta besuchen und versucht sie zu trösten, indem sie ihr die baldige Genesung in Aussicht stellt. Im Gehen vertraut er Annina jedoch an, dass Violetta so schwer krank sei, dass sie nur noch wenige Stunden zu leben habe.

Violetta erfährt von Anna, dass in den Straßen von Paris Karneval gefeiert wird und bittet sie dann 10 *Louis d'or* (die Hälfte des Geldes, das ihr übrig bleibt) zu nehmen und sie draußen unter den Armen zu verteilen. Als Violetta allein ist, holt sie einen Brief von Germont hervor und beginnt ihn zu lesen. In dem Schreiben steht, dass Alfredo und der Baron gut zueinander haben und der letztere dabei, wenn auch nicht schwer, verwundet wurde. Der ins Ausland geflüchtete Alfredo ist von ihm über Violetas Kopf aufgedrückt worden und wird so früh wie möglich zu ihr kommen, um sie um Verzeihung zu bitten, sobald er in die Heimat zurückgekehrt ist. "Es ist zu spät!" kommentiert Violetta betrübt vor dem Spiegel und bemerkt dabei die Veränderungen, die ihre Krankheit bewirkt hat. Sie singt ein Abschiedslied von allen glücklichen Träumen aus der Vergangenheit und hat eine Vision ihres blumen- und namenlosen Grabes. "Lebt wohl vergangene Tage" ist die ergreifende Arie.

F

Le docteur Grenville vient voir Violetta et essaie de la rassurer en lui disant que la guérison est proche. Cependant, en quittant la pièce, il confesse à Annina que la maladie a progressé et qu'il ne reste à Violetta que quelques heures à vivre.

Violetta apprend par Annina que c'est le carnaval dans les rues Paris. Elle ordonne à sa bonne de prendre 10 Louis (la moitié de l'argent qui lui reste) et de les distribuer aux pauvres. Enfin seule, Violetta sort de son corsage une lettre de Germont et commence à la lire: Alfredo s'est battu en duel avec le baron et ce dernier a été légèrement blessé. Alfredo s'est réfugié à l'étranger et a été informé par son père du sacrifice de Violetta. Alfredo revendica donc très bientôt en France pour lui demander pardon. "Si se fait tard", commente Violetta avec tristesse, en regardant dans le miroir les changements causés par la maladie. Elle entonne "Adieu au passé", l'aria touchante des adieux aux rêves de bonheur du passé, et imagine déjà sa tombe sans fleurs et sans nom.
