As the piece begins, the percussion is heard off in the distance, and as the band approaches, more instruments can be heard until the moment the marching band passes by and the entire band is playing. The piece ends as it began, with instruments heard sporadically as the percussion fades away.

Parade Procession allows for students to experience divisi as well as tutti playing within their section. Two contrasting themes, a simple melody moving by steps and small intervals, and a smooth chorale section are complimented by the percussion section, encouraging continuous forward motion.
