Wo sich im Winter auf dem Kitzbüheler Hausberg die weltbesten und wagemutigsten Ski-Abfahrer in die »Mausefalle« stürzen lassen, findet man im Sommer bei einer Bergwanderung Ruhe und Inspiration. So auch der österreichische Komponist und Arrangeur Sepp Leitinger, der hier die Inspiration für seine böhmische »Hahnenkamm-Polka« fand. Musikalisch herausfordernd, zeichnet Leitinger in allen Facetten und mit zünftigen, aber auch großen, lyrischen Bögen den Artenreichtum und die Anmut der Kitzbüheler Alpen und der wohl bekanntesten Ski-Piste der Welt.
